- At least 18 months in a qualifying unit leader equivalent position with direct supervision of at least 1 or more subordinates, Staff experience preferred.
- Ideally no more than 0-4 years of separation from military service.
- Demonstrated learning agility.
- Strong communication skills.
- Forward thinking and able to work through ambiguity.
- Ability to adapt to frequent changes in priority and direction to achieve positive business outcomes.
