Our **Strategy**

The Citi Impact Fund is a \$500 million double-bottom line fund making direct equity investments, from Citi's balance sheet, in U.S.-based companies that are developing innovative solutions to address some of society's most pressing challenges.

- Company Stage: Seed to pre-IPO (with a focus on Series A-C)
- Check Size: \$1MM-\$10MM
- Role: Co-invest alongside other investors
- Ownership: Limited to 4.99% voting shares
- Impact: Alignment with one of four verticals

Our Value-Add

The Citi Impact Fund leverages the full scale of Citi's capabilities and expertise to provide differentiated value-add to help our portfolio companies scale and grow. Key areas of our support for portfolio companies include:

Fast Track to Banking Solutions

Provide banking services, introductions to potential investors, and guidance on transactions for companies exploring M&A or an IPO

Networking Power & Knowledge Sharing

Leverage Citi's events platform to convene portfolio companies, Citi leaders and venture stakeholders, and host webinars with Citi experts

Curated Strategic Support

Facilitate targeted introductions to senior decision makers at Citi to assess potential for pilots and commercialization

Our Investment Process

Initial Diligence

Initial meeting to assess fit with fund mandate, strategy, and investment parameters

Pitch

Company pitch to CIF team and managing directors to obtain approval to conduct full due diligence

Risk Review

CIF team meets with Citi's internal risk and control functions; deals of a certain size may require multiple meetings

Final Approval & Close

Formal investment approval provided by all risk and control functions and completion of legal documentation; funding by Citi

Portfolio Management & Support

Ongoing engagement and delivery of financial reporting, including business and impact KPIs; generally, a board observer role; explore value-add opportunities
