

Basel III Pillar 3 Leverage Ratio Disclosure

Effective January 1, 2013 the Office of the Superintendent of Financial Institutions (OSFI) requires Canadian financial institutions to manage and report regulatory capital in accordance with a new capital management framework, commonly referred to as Basel III. The Basel III Pillar 3 public disclosure requirements are intended to improve both the transparency and comparability of the Bank's capital position and meet the OSFI requirements issued in the OSFI Advisory "Public Disclosure Requirements related to Basel III Leverage Ratio" dated November, 2014. This disclosure has been prepared based on the leverage ratio common disclosure template provided in Annex I – Reporting Table for non-Domestic Systemically Important Banks of the advisory. All balances are presented in Canadian dollars rounded to the nearest thousand, except as otherwise stated.
